NOMINEES AND SUPPORT EX-IM BANK On Apri 21st, SIA announced it was encouraged by the President's nominations to the Board of the Export Import Bank of the United States (Ex-Im Bank) and urged the U.S. Senate to confirm the two nominees. The nominees, if confirmed, would restore a quorum to the Board and permit the Bank to provide credit support for projects exceeding \$10 million. Tom Stroup, President of SIA stated, "In the \$17 billion global satellite manufacturing market, government-backed Export Credit Agencies provide foreign manufacturers with financing tools and a competitive advantage when competing with U.S. companies. Ex-Im Bank, can eliminate that advantage, level the playing field and permit American satellite manufactures to further solidify their leadership position in global market sales and innovation. SIA strongly urges the Senate to take the confirmation actions needed to fully restore the financing capabilities of the Bank." Read more at the SIA News Page HERE.
