SIA FILINGS NEWS SIA OPPOSES BAC PROPOSAL FOR POINT-**TO-MULTIPOINT FIXED** WIRELESS **BROADBAND IN THE 3.7-4.2 GHZ BAND**

On August 7th, SIA submitted a filing with the Federal Communications Commission regarding a petition for rulemaking filed by the Broadband Access Coalition ("BAC") regarding point-to-multi point fixed wireless broadband. SIA opposed the proposal for the simple reason that the relief requested by the BAC would impair, not promote, the stated goals of improving telecommunications access to rural and underserved areas. In the filing, SIA concluded that the BAC's proposal to radically alter the well-established framework for coordinating fixed-satellite service earth stations in the 3700-4200 MHz band is wholly unjustified and contrary to the public interest.
