SIA FILES PETITION TO DISMISS OR DENY WITH FCC REGARDING FWCC PETITION FOR RULEMAKING

On Jan 9th, SIA filed a Petition to Dismiss or Deny with the FCC regarding a petition for rulemaking filed by the Fixed Wireless Communications Coalition (FWCC). That filing reiterates stale and unsupported allegations the FWCC made in 1999 about the supposed adverse effect of full-band, full-arc licensing of fixed-satellite satellite service ("FSS") earth stations on the terrestrial fixed service ("FS"), and requests radical changes to that licensing policy.
