



On May 16th, Inmarsat announced the successful For the second consecutive year, SIA launch of its fourth Global Xpress (GX) broadband The Boeing manufactured I-5 F4 GX satellite was launched on board a SpaceX Falcon 9 launch vehicle from Pad 39-A at the Kennedy Space Center in Florida. The satellite joins three other GX spacecraft previously launched and will add redundancy and further network capacity. SIA Filings and Letters CONTINUES TO ENGAGE HOUSE SUBCOMMITTEE ON SPACE TO REFORM **COMMERCIAL REMOTE SENSING**

Honorable Brian Babin, Chairman Subcommittee on Space House Committee on Science, Space, and Technology and The Honorable Ami Bera, Ranking Member Subcommittee on Space House Committee on Science, Space, and Technology. In the letter, SIA President Tom Stoup thanked both for recently hosting SIA's member companies for a round table discussion on the needs, challenges, and opportunities for reforming the commercial remote sensing regulatory regime in the U.S. SIA noted that the U.S. is clearly a global leader in commercial satellite remote sensing in terms of technology, innovation, bringing new capabilities to market, and leveraging remote sensing data to solve challenging problems. How ever, the remote sensing business changing rapidly, both domestically and internationally, evolving into a digital information services business. This new reality requires regulatory reforms in order to keep the U.S. satellite industry competitive globally, and may necessitate organizational changes within the Dept. of Commerce. On May 8th, the FCC announced that Commission Chairman Ajit Pai had appointed SIA President Tom Stroup to serve on a Broadband Deployment Advisory Committee (BDAC) Working Group. Specifically, Mr. Stroup was named to the Model Code for States Working Group. On May 18th, SIA applauded the action of Chairman Pai and the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) to reduce regulations that currently restrict the way Internet service $% \left(\frac{1}{2}\right) =0$ providers can offer fixed and mobile broadband A Notice of Proposed Rulemaking services. (NPRM) was passed at the May Open Commission In the NPRM, the FCC proposes to Meeting. "restore the Internet to a light-touch regulatory framework by classifying broadband Internet service access as an information service and by seeking comment on the existing rules". "SIA applauds the FCC's efforts to restore the less restrictive framework that helped foster U.S. technological innovation and Internet leadership for the better part of the past two decades," said Tom Stroup, President of SIA. "We also appreciate the Commission's recognition of the critical role satellite broadband plays in the delivery of vital Internet services to customers at home and abroad and the industry looks forward to continuing and expanding that role into the future."
