### SIA APPLAUDS COMMERCE DEPARTMENT SPECTRUM POLICY REPORT **RECOMMENDATIONS**

On Mar 26th, SIA strongly applauded the release of a U.S. Department of Commerce (Dept. of Commerce) Report titled, "Driving Space Commerce Through Effective Spectrum Policy". The report was developed collaboratively with the White House Office of Science and Technology Policy (OSTP), the National Space Council, the National Telecommunications and Information Administration, as well as other Federal entities. The report includes numerous recommendations for improving the U.S. satellite industry and overall space sector through effective spectrum policies and regulations and the coordination of U.S. activities at the International Telecommunications Union (ITU) and other Multi-national forums such as the upcoming 2019 World Radiocommunications Congress (WRC-19). "SIA strongly applauds the Dept. of Commerce, NTIA, OSTP and the National Space Council on the release of today's report which recognizes the critical importance of the commercial satellite industry and the need to provide the industry with adequate access to sufficient radio spectrum," said Tom Stroup, President of SIA. "The commercial satellite industry is going through a remarkable industry transformation. Thanks to tremendous industry leadership and innovation, today's space industry is growing at a tremendous rate. The Dept. of Commerce report estimates that the global space economy may exceed \$1.1 trillion by 2040. SIA and its members look forward to working with all the authors of this report and the FCC to ensure and protect America's continued leadership role in that future space economy." 
