SIA PRESENTS TO NATIONAL SPACE **COUNCIL - FOCUSING ON REGULATORY REFORM, SPECTRUM ACCESS**



On Feb 21st, SIA President Tom Stroup (pictured above) presented on behalf of SIA during the National Space Council Panel Discussion on Entrepreneurship and Economic Expansion on the Next Space Frontier. The panel was part of a Council meeting hosted by NASA's Kennedy Space Center and was chaired by Vice President Mike Pence. "SIA applauds the Council's words regarding the creation of a streamlined regulatory and licensing environment that encourages continued commercial space innovation and entrepreneurship," said Tom Stoup. SIA FILES REPLY COMMENTS WITH THE FCC REGARDING THE USE OF SPECTRUM BANDS ABOVE 24 GHZ

On Feb 23rd, SIA filed reply comments with the FCC in response to the Second Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking regarding spectrum bands above 24 GHz. As SIA explained in its initial comments, the rapidly increasing demand for user capacity across the United States requires access for satellite operators to additional spectrum in order to support these consumers and their need for expanding broadband services. Accordingly, SIA supports more flexible use of the 24.75-25.25 GHz ("24 GHz") band by Fixed Satellite Service ("FSS") systems. See the complete reply comments HERE.

COMMENTS REGARDING SATELLITE AND RURAL TELEHEALTH

On Feb 2nd, SIA filed comments with the FCC in reposnse to its NPRM regarding the promotion of telehealth in rural America and improving the Rural Health Care (RHC) program. SIA noted that the Commission should consider the vital role satellite broadband connectivity plays in improving access to healthcare services in rural areas, and ensure that satellite broadband services are eligible to equitably compete for access to USF funding.
