SPACEX COMPLETES 2023 WITH A TOTAL OF 61 LAUNCHES INCLUDING DEC 8TH ONEWEB LAUNCH OF 40 SATELLITES PLUS A DEC 28TH STARLINK LAUNCH OF 54 SATELLITES



(Above) On Dec 8th, OneWeb announced the successful launch and deployment of 40 of its LEO broadband satellites launched by a SpaceX Falcon 9 launch vehicle from Launch Complex 39-A at the Kennedy Space Center in Cape Canaveral FL. SpaceX also launched 54 Starlink satellites on Dec 28th and completed the year with a record total of 61 launches for 2022, nearly double the record of 31 launches the Company set in 2021.
